

Winder Operator

Shift: 1st Shift 7a-3:30p (OT shift 5a-3:30p)

Position Description:

Employee will train to set up unique machines to form steel coils into tubes. Position includes the following duties:

Job Duties:

- Setup dies for upcoming jobs
- Properly align dies in winder for quality parts processing
- Must be able to use computer to enter information about current job orders
- Load and band coils with a hoist to assist
- Use of precision measuring devices including: Calipers, Check fixtures, depth gages, etc
- Must be able to routinely lift and manage a maximum of 100lbs
- Fork Truck license and experience required
- Personal transportation required
- Monitor for material and process quality
- Employee will also frequently use band saws and plasma torch to cut materials off machine.
